CONDITIONS OF BOOKING, SITE USE AND SITE INFORMATION

BOOKING FORMS

All Bookings MUST be accompanied by a completed Booking Form, Signed Acceptance of Conditions of Booking, Site Use and Information (In the case of Tunbridge Wells Groups, a copy will not be required on each occasion, provide that the Party Leader has previously submitted a signed Acceptance of Conditions of Booking, Site Use and Information).

ARRIVAL

The Warden or a member of the Adamswell Committee will normally meet you on your arrival at the site (unless otherwise arranged).

VEHICLES

In the interest of safety no vehicles are allowed on the grassed areas other than to load/unload. Then only with the permission of the Site Warden if the ground is dry.

PLEASE NOTE THERE IS A SPEED LIMIT OF 5 M.P.H THROUGH OUT THE SITE!

PARKING

Use the surfaced area around the building or the designated car parks.
Parking is not permitted on the grassed areas of the campsite.
Parking in the turning circle is permitted provided that the gate is not obstructed in case of emergencies

PLEASE NOTE : VEHICLES AND CONTENTS ARE LEFT AT THE CAMPSITE ENTIRELY AT OWNERS RISK.

BUILDING

When the Warden or a Member of the Adamswell Committee meets you, you will be given the keys to the hut and be shown around and given further information on use of the hut.

PLEASE NOTE: This hut is self-catering and you will need to supply your own cleaning materials, toilet paper and hand towels, etc. On completion of your booking, the Checklist displayed in the building should be complied with.

CAMPING

You will be shown where you are camping either as previously agreed or as deemed by the Warden.

WATER

Water points are positioned throughout the campsite and, as the water supply is metered it is requested that campers co-operate by turning the taps off after use.

FIREWOOD

There is a woodpile on site that is topped up on a regular basis. If it is your intention to cook on Altar Fires, please note that we do make a small Daily / Weekly charge for wood as we have to buy in our wood supplies. At the end of your stay, all unused firewood should be returned to the woodpile. **DO NOT LEAVE UNUSED FIREWOOD NEAR YOUR VACATED SITE** (it may seem to be a kind gesture to leave a pile of firewood near your vacated site for the use of future campers, but experience shows this is not used. This then forms an eyesore and hazard on the site). No trees of any description may be cut or felled without express permission of the Warden.

FIRES

You are welcome to use fires to cook on but you must NOT dig out fireplaces in the ground. Either bring your own altar fires, or use the ones on site.

PITS

The digging of pits of any kind is not permitted on the site. This includes fireplaces, wet pits, rubbish pits, etc. Instead of a wet pit, we suggest you use a plastic sack with holes punched into it, held up on a simple frame.

NOISE

Out of consideration for our Neighbours and other people using the site please avoid making unnecessary noise before 07.00 and after 22.30
During the day please keep Radios, etc, turned very low.

PETS

No pets of any description are allowed on the campsite.
The only dogs permitted are registered guide dogs for the visually impaired.

FIREWORKS

Fireworks will only be permitted during the period of two weeks either side of 5th November each year. Please ask for further information.

BOUNDARYS

Please note the stretch of river from the hut to the Brick Bridge is out of bounds.

The drive along Beeches field that has a small fence along it and the Railway line are also out of bounds.

ACCIDENTS

Details of all accidents involving injury to persons or damage to property should be reported to the warden as soon as possible.

There is a pay phone on site but this will only accept coins.

INTERNET

Internet facilities are available within the Building. Use of these facilities must be arranged with the Site Warden.

RUBBISH

There is a refuse collection service from the campsite. Please therefore ensure that all rubbish is put into Black Sacks and placed in the Blue Wheelie Bin at the rear of the building before leaving the site.

TOILETS

If you are not using the hut you are advised to bring your own Elsan type toilets with you. There are two disposal points on site. There are outside toilets near to the Wood Pile, but these have very limited capacity. It is your responsibility to keep the toilets clean. Please note toilet paper is **NOT** supplied.

DEPARTURE

The Warden or Adamswell Committee member will inspect that you have cleaned the hut in accordance with the checklist displayed in the hut.
Camper's sites will also be inspected to see that the area has been left clean and tidy.
